To teach "Down," start with your puppy in a sit. Hold a treat near their nose and slowly lower it towards the floor and then slightly away from them between their paws. As they follow the treat down, they should naturally lie down. As their elbows touch the ground, say "Down," click, and treat. Again, start with luring and gradually fade the lure, relying on the verbal cue.

Addressing Common Puppy Behaviors

Puppies explore the world with their mouths, and nipping is a natural part of their development. However, it needs to be managed effectively.

Managing Nipping and Biting

When your puppy nips too hard, yelp loudly, mimicking a littermate's reaction. Immediately withdraw attention for a few seconds. If the nipping persists, redirect their chewing to an appropriate chew toy. Offer praise and treats when they chew on their toys. This teaches them what is acceptable to chew. For persistent mouthing, consider a **positive reinforcement dog trainer** to help guide you through techniques like bite inhibition.

Preventing Destructive Chewing

Puppies chew to explore, relieve teething discomfort, and release energy. Provide a variety of appropriate chew toys. Rotate them to keep things interesting. Puppy-proof your home by removing anything you don't want chewed. If you catch your puppy chewing something inappropriate, interrupt them with a sound and immediately redirect them to an appropriate chew toy. Ensure your puppy is getting enough physical and mental stimulation; a tired puppy is less likely to be a destructive puppy.
