Briefly review the key concepts that will be covered. This isn't about cramming but about refreshing their memory on topics like multiplication facts, fraction basics, or geometry terms. Remind them that the goal is to learn and improve, not to achieve a perfect score immediately. Emphasize that mistakes are opportunities for growth.

Engaging with the Test Material

During the practice test, encourage the student to read each question carefully. If they encounter a word problem, they should identify what the problem is asking, what information is given, and what steps they need to take. For younger students, it can be beneficial to read the questions aloud. Encourage them to show their work, even for problems that seem simple. This not only helps them track their thought process but also allows parents and teachers to identify where misconceptions might be occurring. If they get stuck, advise them to skip the problem and return to it later, rather than getting bogged down and frustrated.

Analyzing Results and Targeted Practice
