1. **3521 - Automotive Maintenance:** Repairing and maintaining vehicles, from light trucks to heavy equipment.
2. **3531 - Small/Medium Tactical Vehicle Operator:** Driving and maintaining vehicles like the High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle (HMMWV) and the Medium Tactical Vehicle Replacement (MTVR).
3. **3533 - Heavy Equipment Operator:** Operating specialized vehicles such as bulldozers and cranes for construction and engineering tasks.

Supply and Logistics (30xx)

Ensuring that the right supplies reach the right place at the right time is a critical function.

1. **3043 - Logistics/Embarkation Specialist:** Planning and executing the movement of personnel and equipment during deployments and operations.
2. **3051 - Logistics Vehicle System Operator:** Operating and maintaining the large, modular Logistics Vehicle System (LVS) for heavy cargo transport.

Maintenance and Repair (21xx, 31xx)

Keeping weapons, equipment, and vehicles operational requires skilled technicians.

1. **2111 - Small Arms, Artillery, and Light Weapons Repairer:** Maintaining and repairing the weapons that Marines rely on.
2. **2141 -.5's and .30 Caliber Machine Gun Repairer:** Specializing in the repair of specific types of crew-served weapons.
3. **3152 - Airframes Repairer:** Maintaining and repairing the airframes of Marine Corps aircraft.

Services (33xx, 34xx)

These MOSs focus on essential services that maintain the well-being and efficiency of the force.

1. **3311 - Mess Hall Cook:** Preparing meals for Marines, a vital morale booster.
2. **3451 - Financial Management Resource Assessor:** Managing the financial resources of Marine Corps units.

3. Aviation MOSs: Dominance of the Skies

The USMC operates a powerful aviation wing, providing air support, reconnaissance, and troop transport. These MOSs require highly specialized technical skills and rigorous training.

Aircraft Maintenance (6xxx)
