computer's file system and select the YouTube video file you previously downloaded.

6. **Insert the Video:** Click the 'Insert' button.
7. **Position and Resize:** Adjust the video's position and size on the slide as needed.
8. **Playback Options:** In slideshow mode, the video will play directly from your computer. You'll have options to control playback behavior.

Playback Options for Downloaded Videos:

When you click this link in slideshow mode, your PowerPoint will attempt to open the YouTube video in your default web browser. This can be jarring for your audience and is difficult to manage seamlessly. It also still requires an internet connection.

Especially if relying on online embedding, technical glitches can happen. Have a backup plan, such as a downloaded version of the video or a relevant screenshot with a link, in case of internet connectivity issues.
