With the yellow cross in place, we now focus on getting the yellow stickers of the corner pieces to face upwards. The positions of these corners might still be incorrect at this stage.

The "Sune" and "Anti-Sune" Algorithms

We use algorithms to orient the yellow corners. The most common algorithms are variations of the "Sune" and "Anti-Sune":

1. **Sune (R U R' U R U2 R')**: This algorithm orients one yellow corner that is facing you and to the right.
2. **Anti-Sune (L' U' L U' L' U2 L)**: This is the mirror image and orients a corner facing you and to the left.

Hold the cube so that a yellow corner that needs orienting is in the front-right position. Apply the "Sune" algorithm. If that corner is now oriented correctly, move to the next corner that needs orienting (without rotating the entire cube, only the top layer if necessary) and repeat the algorithm. Continue this process until all yellow corners are oriented.

It's important to note that sometimes you might need to perform the "Sune" algorithm twice or more on the same

corner to get it oriented correctly. The key is to keep the same front-right corner in position and repeat the algorithm until it's solved, then move to the next unsolved corner.

Step 6: Permuting the Yellow Corners

At this point, all the yellow stickers should be facing up, forming a solid yellow face. However, the yellow corner pieces might not be in their final positions. This step involves swapping these corners until they are correctly placed relative to the side centers.

Finding Adjacent or Opposite Corners

Look for two corner pieces that are already in their correct positions relative to each other. If you find two adjacent corners that are correctly positioned, hold the cube so that these two correct corners are at the front-right and back-right positions. If no adjacent corners are correct, you might have two opposite corners in the correct relative position. In this case, hold the cube so that one of the correct corners is at the front-right.

The Corner Permutation Algorithm

The algorithm to swap corners is: **U R U' L' U R' U' L**.

Perform this algorithm. After each execution, check if the corners are in their correct positions. You may need to perform it once or twice. If you had adjacent correct corners, performing the algorithm will likely solve all four. If you had opposite correct corners, you might need to perform it, then re-evaluate your corner positions and potentially perform it again.

Step 7: Permuting the Yellow Edges – The Final Step!

The final step is to position the yellow edge pieces correctly. At this stage, the yellow face is complete, and the white and middle layers are solved. Only the yellow edge pieces might be out of place.

Identifying Misplaced Edges

Look at the yellow edge pieces. If one is in the correct spot, hold the cube so that this correctly placed edge is at the back. If no edge pieces are in the correct spot, you can perform the algorithm from any side, and it will put at least one edge into the correct position.

The Edge Permutation Algorithm

The algorithm to cycle the remaining three yellow edges is:

1. **To cycle edges clockwise: R U R' U R U2 R' U**
2. **To cycle edges counter-clockwise: U R U' R' U R U2 R'** (or apply the clockwise version three times)

Alternatively, a commonly taught algorithm that cycles three edges is: **R2 U R U R' U' R' U' R' U R'**.

Hold the cube so that the correctly placed edge (if any) is at the back. Apply the algorithm. You may need to perform it once or twice, depending on the permutation. After each execution, check if all edges are in place. If all edges are correctly positioned, congratulations! You have solved the Rubik's Cube!

Once you've mastered the layer-by-layer method, you can focus on speed and efficiency:

1. **Algorithm Memorization:** Practice each algorithm until it becomes second nature.
2. **Lookahead:** Try to anticipate the next step while executing the current one.

4. **Advanced Methods:** Explore methods like CFOP (Cross, F2L, OLL, PLL) or Roux for faster solving times.
