It's a book that doesn't offer comfort or easy answers, but instead, provides a profound and enduring insight into the human experience of disillusionment and the unsettling realization that sometimes, even in the midst of purported awakening, society can find itself irrevocably slouching towards an uncertain, and perhaps, terrifying new dawn.
